



## How to get to Nintoku-tenno-ryo Kofun (★1)

●**By Shinkansen Bullet Train** Take the JR Line from Shin-Osaka Station, and get off at Osaka Station. Change to the Kansai Airport or Kishu Rapid Express, and get off at Mikunigaoka Station. Change to the local train and get off at JR Hanwa Line Mozu Station (total travel time: about 50 min.). Walk west for 500 m.

●**By Plane** Get on the rapid express from JR Kansai Airport Station, get off at Otori Station, then change to the local train and get off at Mozu Station (total travel time: about 45 min.). Walk west for 500 m.

●**By Car** About 10 min. southeast by car from the "Sakai" exit off of the Hanshin Expressway No. 15 Sakai Route.

\*Parking is limited, so please use public transportation if possible.



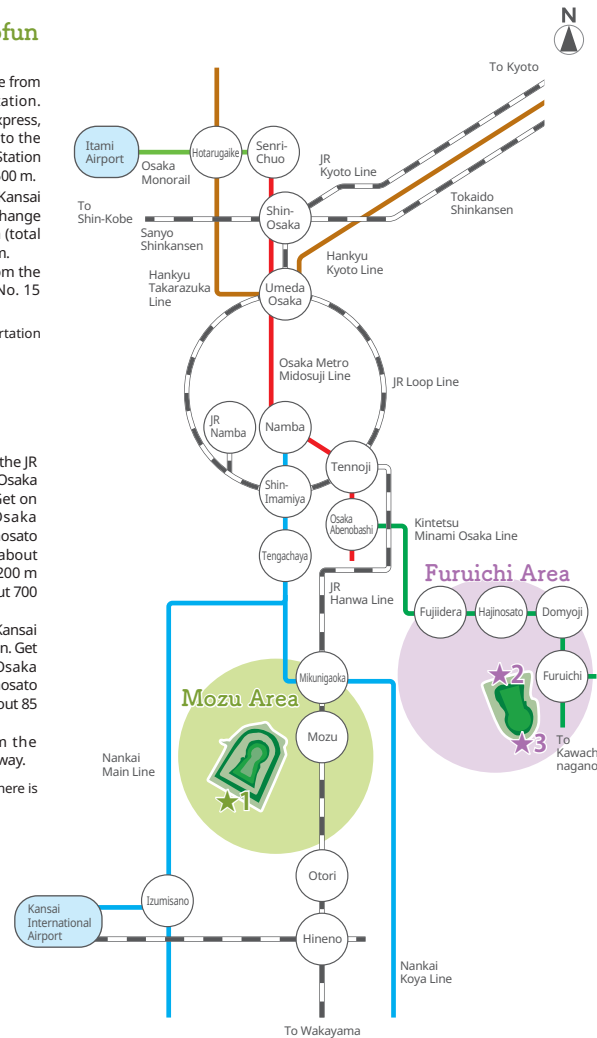
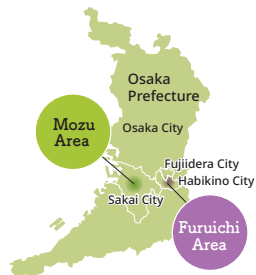
## How to get to Ojin-tenno-ryo Kofun (★2, 3)

●**By Shinkansen Bullet Train** Get on either the JR Line or the Osaka Metro Midosuji Line at Shin-Osaka Station, and then get off at Tennoji Station. Get on the semi-express at adjoining Kintetsu Osaka Abenobashi Station, and get off at either Hajinosato Station or Furuichi Station (total travel time: about 60 min.). The Ojin-tenno-ryo Kofun is about 1200 m southwest of Hajinosato Station (★2) and about 700 m northwest of Furuichi Station (★3).

●**By Plane** Get on the rapid express from JR Kansai Airport Station, and then get off at Tennoji Station. Get on the semi-express at adjoining Kintetsu Osaka Abenobashi Station, and get off at either Hajinosato Station or Furuichi Station (total travel time: about 85 min.).

●**By Car** About 5 min. south by car from the "Fujidera" exit off of the Nishi-Meihan Expressway.

\*Please use public transportation when visiting. There is no parking near the Ojin-tenno-ryo Kofun.



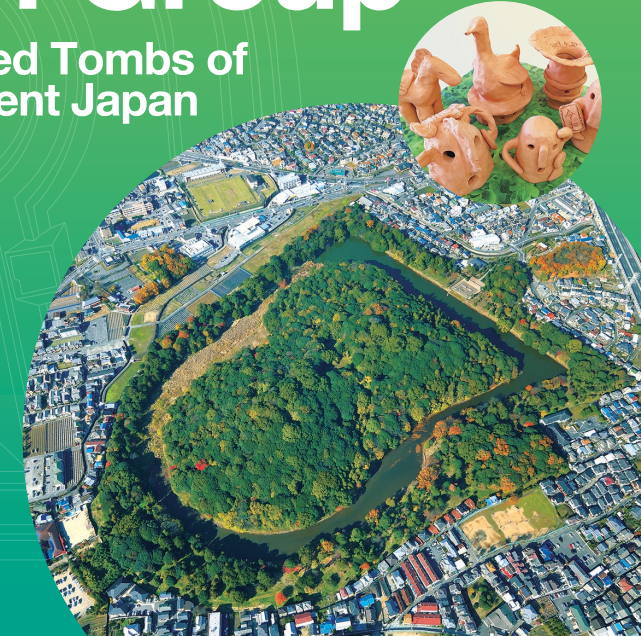

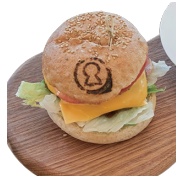

Mounded tombs are the burial mounds that act as tombs for ancient kings and royalty. Large tombs also serve as symbols of authority, and were made all over the world. In Japan there are the circular "round mounded tombs," the quadrilateral "square mounded tombs," and the both round and square "keyhole-shaped mounded tombs." There are many large and small mounded tombs, including the "Nintoku-tenno-ryo Kofun," one of the world's three largest burial mounds.

You can experience their size from up close, or look on their beautiful form from a distant vantage. There are many ways to enjoy the mounded tombs. Enjoy the view like a person in ancient times from the "climbable mounded tomb," or see all of the kofun mounded tombs together from the sky with a sightseeing flight. There are also mounded tombs that change with the seasons, with cherry blossom trees and autumn leaves.

Dotted around the large mounded tombs are "satellite tombs (Baizuka)." It is possible to get comparatively closer to these smaller mounds, so you can get a good look. You can enjoy these mounded tombs up close. Don't forget to check out the excavated haniwa clay figures and ornaments at the nearby museum and archive center.

The hill you can see directly in front of the ticket gate of Hajinosato station is the Nabezuka Kofun. It can be fully scaled via the satellite tomb of Nakatsuhime-no-mikoto-ryo Kofun.

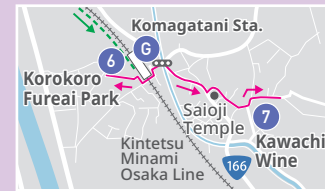
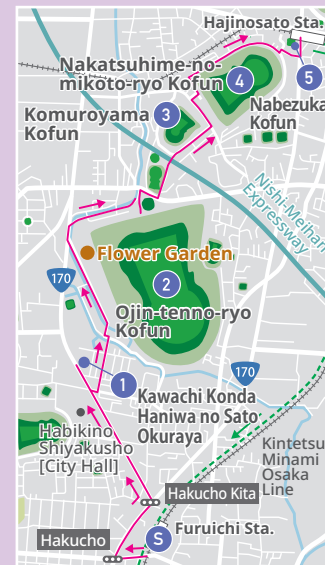

The Furuichi area is at the junction of the historic Takenouchi-kaido and the Higashi Koya-kaido roads, and thus it has many historic spots. You can fully enjoy history and mounded tombs at places such as the Ojin-tenno-ryo Kofun, which has Japan's second longest burial mound, and a temple connected to historic leader and scholar Sugawara no Michizane, as well as through things like the national treasure metal saddle fittings excavated from the Kondamaruyama Kofun. We recommend visiting in spring for the beautiful cherry and plum blossoms.

**1 Domyoji Temple**

A convent built by Haji, an ancestor of Sugawara no Michizane and said to have been visited by Michizane himself. Famous as the birthplace of "Domyoji Hoshii (dried boiled rice)" and "Domyoji Ko" (rice flour), used for Kansai-style sakura mochi. The national treasure 11-Faced Kannon Bosatsu statue is displayed to the public on the 18th and 25th of every month.

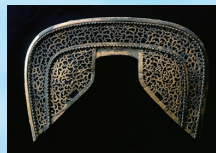

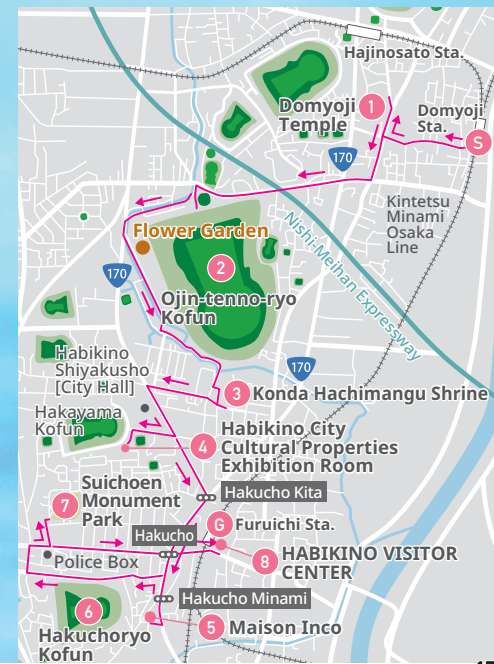

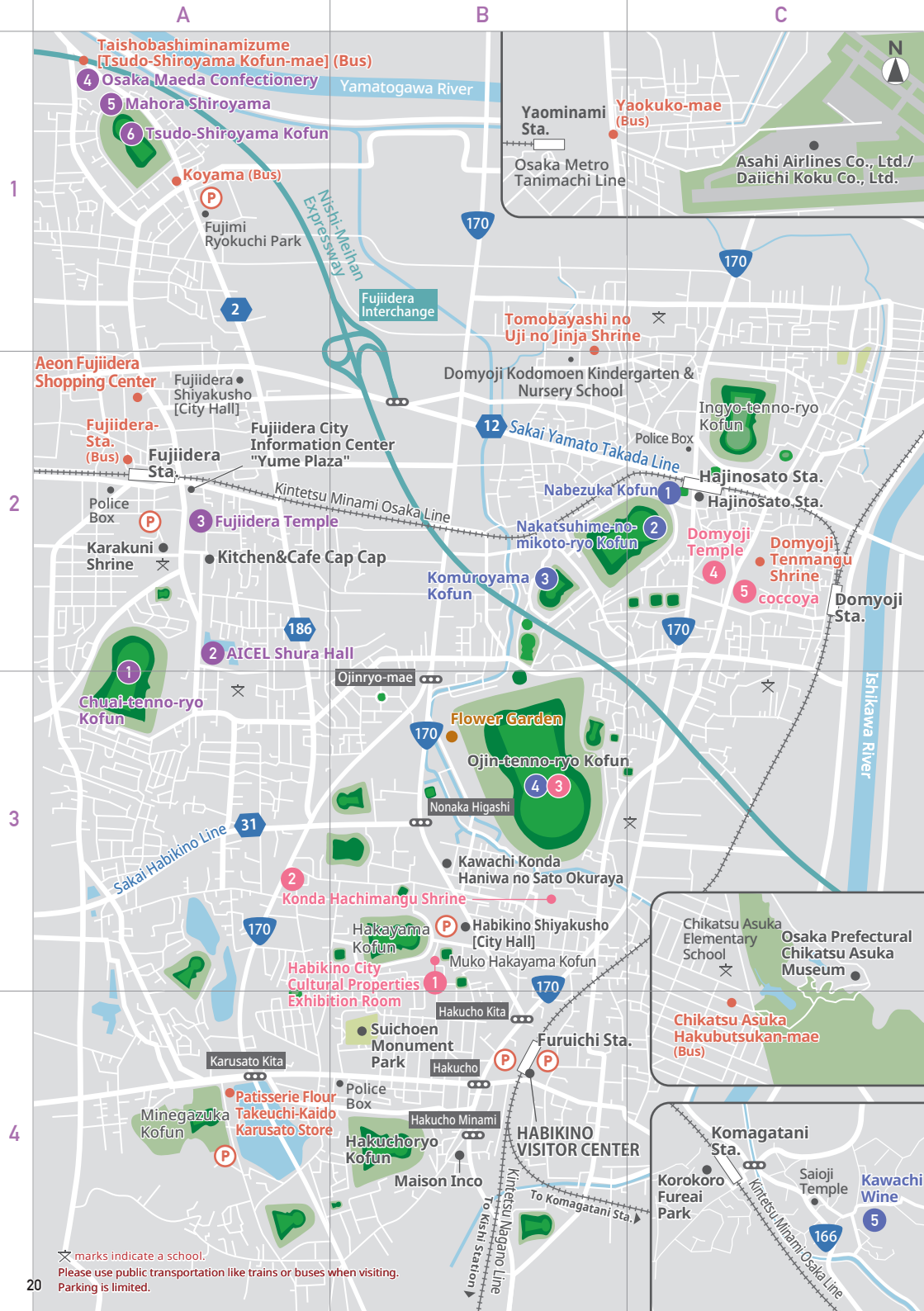
